

Healthy Hints from our Congregational Health Team

Cut Risk of Head and Neck Cancer by 400%--Take good care of your smile and you'll have more than just white teeth to show for it. New research from Roswell Park Cancer Institute, Buffalo, NY, shows that people with the chronic gum disease periodontitis have a fourfold risk of developing a type of head or neck cancer, especially in the mouth or throat. The risk was increased even among patients who never used tobacco. Gum disease occurs when the bacteria that live in plaque infect the gums, so brush and floss regularly to prevent plaque buildup, and see your dentist every six months for a cleaning and exam.
