FREE BLOOD PRESSURE CHECKS will be given by nurses after church **today**. Please also feel free to stop by and ask them any questions about this issue.

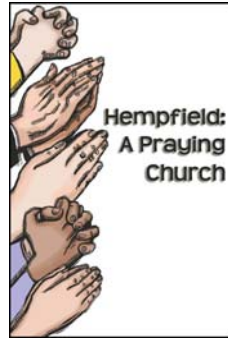

Healthy Hints from our Congregational Health Team

Tips for back-pack shopping at
<http://www.aap.org/advocacy/releases/augschool.cfm>:

- Choose a backpack with wide, padded shoulder straps and a padded back.
- Pack light. Organize the backpack to use all of its compartments. Pack heavier items closest to the center of the back. The backpack should never weigh more than 10 to 20 percent of your child’s body weight.
- Always use both shoulder straps. Slinging a backpack over one shoulder can strain muscles.
- Consider a rolling backpack. This type of backpack may be a good choice for students who must tote a heavy load. Remember that rolling backpacks still must be carried up stairs, and they may be difficult to roll in snow.
