### Healthy Hints from our Congregational Health Team

**Raw or cooked?** Though raw produce is often assumed to be more nutritious than cooked, a mix of both kinds gives you more healthy options. For example:  
*Tomatoes* – Cooked, these have a higher dose of cancer-fighting lycopene.  
*Green bell peppers* – You'll keep more vitamin B if you eat these raw.  
*Zucchini* – Squash delivers more beta-carotene (a building block for Vitamin A) when cooked. *Spinach* – Raw spinach has more Vitamin C and folate. Cooked, it's richer in calcium and zinc. *Garlic* – Garlic's health-protecting antimicrobial power is dimmed by cooking.

We, the Chuwan family, are so much pleased and excited for the great help and gift given by your church (Hempfield Church) even from a simple paper to a big car. And you find job too for Chatra. It is an unexpected and incredible help for us which you have done since our arrival in the US. We ourselves feel that our lives have been changed and improved due to the sponsorship of Hempfield Church. It is remarkable. We have no words other than to say, "Thank you so much!" God bless you all the members of the church. We only know that we spent our life as refugees in Nepal for 17 years, and we cried a lot. And now we pray to God and say, "Don't lead anyone to the refugee life. Humans will have different lives in the world, but among them refugee life is the worst life, as we experienced." It is definite that those who help others are helped by God in turn. So I do hope the same for you and your church family members too.
