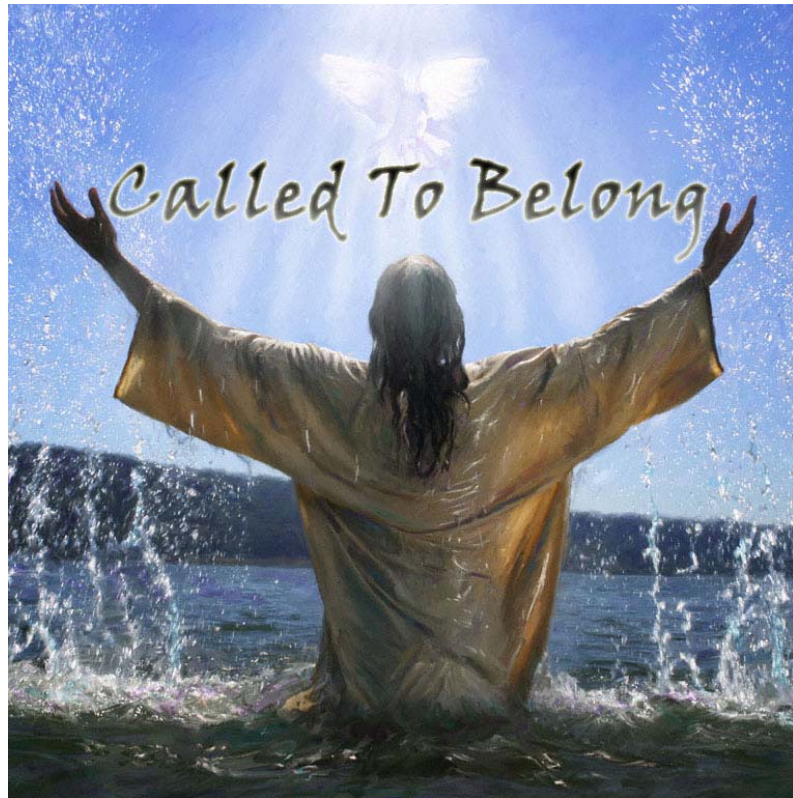

Come "Glean" With Us

The Force for Food Committee is sponsoring a group of adults and kids 10 years and older to spend the weekend of October 21-23 helping to feed the local hungry and increase awareness of world hunger.

The event is part of the Society of St. Andrew Harvest of Hope Experience and includes a weekend retreat of "Gleaning," Study, Worship, Meals and Commitment from Friday evening October 21 through Sunday Morning October 23 at Gretna Glen Campgrounds (Mount Gretna).

The purpose of the weekend is for participants to:

- harvest crops by hand to donate to local food banks and soup kitchens (gleaning);
- learn about domestic and global hunger;
- bring into focus the relationship between faith and service to the poor;
- partake in good nutritious meals and covenant to abstain from "junk food" and soda for the entire event; and
- hopefully take what they experience back home with them so they might impact their families, communities, and churches.

Cost of the weekend is \$75 per participant. The committee will cover \$25 of the cost for the first 8 people who sign up.
