Breeze Highlight



Breeze is our online church directory that can make your life easier and help you stay connected with other members of our church family.

On our church website (www.hempfieldcob.org) in the bottom left corner, you can find links to log into the Breeze database and view tutorial videos that will help you get going and keep going in Breeze. ***If your e-mail is registered with the church office, you can create your personal account from the Login button.***

This week we are highlighting the following feature of Breeze:

Find out who has a church mailbox

Have you ever wanted to drop off something at the church for a church member to pick up on Sunday? Or perhaps you want to save postage on sending thank-you cards (or Valentine's Day cards ☺) to church members?

Well, using the church mailboxes can help! They are located in the outer office, but, due to space constraints, not every church member has a mailbox. Boxes are assigned to ministry team members and others who fill various roles at the church. Breeze can make your life easier by telling you who has a church mailbox and who does not.

Find out if an individual has a mailbox

Simply type the individual's name into the search bar in the top left corner of Breeze and pull up his profile page. Look under the "contact" section of his page and see if the field "Church mailbox?" says "yes" or "no."

See a list of everyone who has a church mailbox

Click on "show more filter options" on the people page. Then from the list of options, click on "Church Mailbox?" and select "Yes." This will give you a list of everyone who has a church mailbox.
