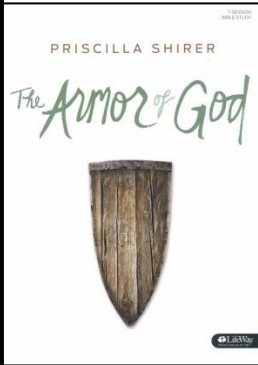

Ladies Bible Study



The Thursday morning Ladies Bible Study will be using the 7-session DVD along with the book, *The Armor of God*, Bible Study Book by Priscilla Shirer for our 2017 Fall – Winter Session. An online option led by Laura Meiser is available.
