FOOD PANTRY NEEDS—Items requested for June: 24 oz. cans spaghetti sauce, cereal, canned pineapple, 18 oz. strawberry jelly, boxed pasta, and chunky peanut butter. Egg cartons are no longer needed. Please continue to donate grocery bags. In April the pantry served 145 families of which 188 were children; 358 adults; 78 seniors for a total 624 persons served. An average of 75-100 families visit the pantry each week. “Thank you” to Hempfield Church of the Brethren members who contributed 199 pounds of food items to the pantry during the month of April.
