FOOD PANTRY THANK YOU—Thank you for the donation of 60 pounds of food and \$100 contribution in September. **Monetary contributions help the pantry to purchase items** not regularly donated like meat and eggs as well as "high demand" items like cereal, rice, peanut butter, jelly, canned vegetables, soups, and fruits. Financial contributions also allow the pantry to purchase food items at the Central Penn Food Bank once a month at greatly reduced prices. **Due to the closing of Darrenkamps (whom we will miss greatly!!)**...the pantry will no longer receive their weekly donations of fresh produce. Consequently, fresh produce is another item the pantry will have to purchase through your financial contributions. In September, the pantry served 148 families which totaled 612 people served and included: 184 children; 330 adults; and 98 seniors. In addition to the clients who visit the pantry to select their food items, deliveries are made to senior citizens, and families who are unable to get to the pantry due to physical disabilities or lack of transportation.
