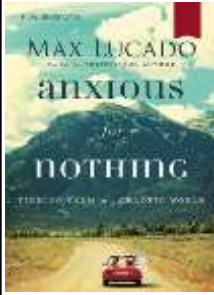

# Ladies Spring Bible Study
